Dear Wales Green Party member,

This questionnaire is sent to you as part of the first international survey of green party members across Europe. The aim of this survey is to understand more about the backgrounds, beliefs and activities of Wales Green Party members. We hope that you will take the time to complete this questionnaire which should only take about 40-50 minutes.

This questionnaire is being mailed to all members of the Wales Green Party with the help of the party office in Cardiff. Your individual anonymity is guaranteed. There are no numbers or other marks on the questionnaire, and neither we nor anybody else will be able to identify individual responses; the Party will only receive an overall analysis of the replies.

The questions we will ask you cover a wide range of subjects. Most of them can be answered by ticking the box beside the answer you would like to give. No special knowledge is needed to fill in the questionnaire, and we are sure that everyone will be able to give an opinion on all questions. We want all people to take part, not just those with strong views about a particular issue. We think you will find the questionnaire interesting and enjoyable. It should be completed only by the person to whom it was sent, so that responses will reflect all shades of opinion within the Welsh Greens.

The survey is part of an international scientific project studying members of green parties across Western Europe funded by the British Academy and the University of Strathclyde. Surveys of green party members in Norway, Sweden, Finland, Scotland, England, the Netherlands, Belgium, France, Germany, Austria, Italy and Greece have already been completed in 2002. In early 2003, further surveys are conducted in Spain and New Zealand.
